

Chair Report - May 2018

It's been a good month. The last meet went quite well and I am working on some ideas to get even better with communication for the athletes and their families about what is expected. We got all our Synchro BC raffle tickets turned in and ended up being some big winners (tickets sold by our club won the \$1000 grand prize, one of the \$500 and a \$100)

The Watershow went well and I have heard from some of the guests that they were blown away by the skill and artistry our club is putting out (and especially for the ages of the swimmers) I think it worked well with the See It Try It following the show and had 11 families with 15 girls. I have filed their email addresses in a contact group so that we can easily reach out for the new season and possible summer camps.

Heather and I have met with (and Heather has been spear-heading on our club's behalf) groups of various pool-users in relation to the RDN proposal for changes to the Ravensong Pool. We plan on attending the committee meeting on the 17th and have made arrangements to appear as a delegation. We are encouraging the RDN to reconsider their plan (that would drastically affect pool use during construction) and have discussed with other groups what viable options could work more efficiently and will be sharing that.

Overall, the feedback was positive and respondents were forthcoming with ideas, thoughts and constructive information that we will be able to use to further develop our club's policies, procedures and overall operations.
