

## **President Report - November 18th 2019**

Club clothing order has been submitted. We need to rethink how we do this as we are causing a lot of issue for our supplier due to small orders. He has continued to give us extremely low prices but will not be able to continue as he is losing money. He has already said he has ordered the items for this year but has asked us to rethink our ordering strategy for uniforms etc. We have already been working with him to reduce the number of brands we use, as that is another way we can help him to continue offering us these great prices. I think this is something that might fit into the discussion about our fees for next year.

I have been in touch with local user clubs of Ravensong and we are trying to work with the Oceanside Services Committee of RDN in the redesign of Ravensong and any possible builds. Currently, they are requesting what we would like to see for a pool design that would work best for us and have a meeting we are invited to attend on November 28th. I am able to attend and Heather has suggested if someone wanted to step into her place as she is unable to attend a full meeting, that could be more beneficial.

Stretch classes, overall, are being highly commended by those members in attendance who are all seeing big improvement in their flexibility and learning a lot about proper warm-up and technique for different stretches. Thanks to Glenny, the instructor, we were able to keep the 6 interested club members attending, as she found other members to supplement the running of the class.

We are slowly plugging away at the Policy updates, but we are being thorough and creating a document that should last (with minor updates annually) and prove resourceful for future boards. On the topic of Boards, I think it will be important to start driving home the need for new Board members for next year soon, as I already know of a few that are planning to take a break from their positions. I think after the holiday season would be appropriate, so we are not leaving too little time to fill positions and possible interested parties can shadow roles earlier, if wanted.

For the next meet (Dec), I would like to suggest the Synchro BC awards dinner as an option for those that might be interested in a team dinner, as we have a few athletes who will be getting recognized.
